Working with local landscape architect David Renzi of [Out in Front Horticulture](#), Wilcox Park Manager Alan Peck, OSEEC [AmeriCorps](#) members and Chariho High School, in April we created a rain garden as part of an education pilot project to demonstrate sustainable landscaping and storm water management. The 1,000 square-foot garden — which consists of native plants from Blue Moon Farm Perennials, stones, gravel and mulch — will substantially redirect and filter runoff from a paved parking lot above the park land.
